Auto-Test Supplementary Regulations

Date: __20th June 2021 __

Venue: __Royal Welsh Showground, Llanelwedd__

General Regulations:

1. Epynt Motor Club Ltd. will organise a clubman's auto test on at the date and venue above.
2. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the Motorsport UK, (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these supplementary regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.
3. A Motorsport UK Permit Number has been issued. Permit Number: 119918
4. The event is run under a clubmans permit and only open to members of Epynt Motor Club.
5. All competitors and drivers must produce a valid club membership card or have obtained online confirmation of club membership prior to the event. All competitors must hold a valid Motorsport UK RS Clubman or higher grade competition licence. A Motorsport UK RS Clubman Competition Licence is free of charge and can be applied for online at www.motorsportuk.org in advance. Applications for Licenses or membership will not be accepted on the day.
 - a. Membership status will be confirmed with the Membership Secretary.
 - b. You will need to send a copy of your Motorsport UK License prior to the running of the event to the entries secretary.
6. A competitor must be at least 16 years of age to compete.
 - a. Parents or guardians of drivers under 18 years of age must complete the required paperwork in advance.
 - b. A competitor under 18 years of age may only compete in the Standard class.
7. The maximum entry for the meeting is 20 plus 3 reserves. The minimum is 5.

9. Any protest must be lodged in accordance with H35.1.6.
10. Practicing will not be allowed.
11. There will be an official event photographer in attendance throughout the event. By signing onto the event, you agree that the car and driver can be photographed / filmed during the event and that any photos / film taken by the official event photographer may be used by the event and organising club for the promotional purposes.
 - a. If you do not wish to be photographed / filmed during the event, please make the organisers aware.

Technical Regulations:

12. All vehicle must comply with Motorsport UK Technical Regulations except the following which have been modified:-
 - a. J5.17.2 – A form of silencer must be fitted.



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- b. All cars must be fitted with an effective silencer at all times.
13. Marking and penalties will be as printed in the appropriate section of the Motorsport UK General Regulations except as modified below:-
- a. M7C – Not performing a test correctly. Slowest Time + 10 seconds.
 - b. M7E- failure to stop at finish line. 10 seconds.
14. All the following regulations of the Motorsport UK apply as written except for the following which are modified:-
- a. M12 – No passenger is allowed to be carried on any test.
 - b. M6.6 – Markers may be less than 1 meter in height.

Schedule of the Event:

15. The programme of the meeting will be:-
- a. Starting Order, Route Diagrams and other relevant information will be sent to all competitors and marshals 48 hours before the event.
 - b. All competitors must arrive and be parked up by 10:00am
 - c. First Car starts at 10:45am.
16. Route Information will be attached to the joining instructions. These tests must be printed out by the competitors. THEY WILL NOT BE SUPPLIED ON THE DAY. This will be approximately 4 to 8 sheets of paper single side, or 2 to 4 sheets if printed double sided (1 test per page).
17. Each driver will have 2 runs of each test to count for results. Timing will be by hand-held stopwatch and results will be displayed ON A LARGE WHITEBOARD for SOCIALLY DISTANCED VIEWING!!!. The starting signal will be done through a 3...2..1. hand signal to the driver. The starting order will be determined in advance and communicated via the joining instructions. Car 1 will start Test 1 first, Car 2 will start Test 2 first and so on throughout the day.
18. Competitors will need to have a piece of paper showing their name and start number CLEARLY DISPLAYED ON THEIR WINDSCREEN/SIDE WINDOW for the marshal to record your time appropriately.
19. The marshal will give a thumbs up signal to confirm you are ready, reply with a thumbs up to confirm, the marshal will then start your timed test in accordance with the starting procedure above.

Entries:

20. The entry list opens on ___7pm on Friday 4th June 2021. The Entry & Reserves List will be drawn up on Saturday 12th June 2021 and confirmed to competitors on Sunday 13th June.
21. The entry fee is: £25 and must be paid by BACS. ** YOUR ENTRY WONT BE ACCEPTED UNTIL PAYMENT IS CONFIRMED**
- a. Please use the Drivers Name as the Reference.
 - b. Proof of payment is not required, but would be welcome to the entries secretary.
 - c. All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee.

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22. Entries will be accepted under the following criteria; A Number of places will be offered to regular championship competitors thereafter it will be in order of confirmed paid entries. Entries will not be acknowledged but will be accepted and considered for entry list once the appropriate fee has been paid and checks confirmed.

24. Please note the sharing of cars are not permitted, unless from within the same physical household or extended household bubble.
25. The event will consist of 5 classes as following (*Awards will not be handed out at the event, but dealt with after the event*):-
- a. Front Wheel Drive
 - b. Rear Wheel Drive
 - c. Standard Production
 - i. All cars in the standard class must have a STANDARD engine, NO LSD or welded diffs, NO knobbly or winter tyres and NO hydraulic handbrake.
 - d. Novice
 - i. A competitor entering the novice class will remain in the novice class for the year.
 - e. Ladies
26. More than one entry per vehicle is permitted provided:-
- a. The both entrants are from within the same physical household or extended household bubble.
27. We take privacy seriously and will only use personal information to administer entries, including providing a public Entry List and sending emails in connection with an entry. This will include passing your information to a secure third party system for the purpose of timing tests and providing a results service.

Championship Specific Regulations:

28. The event is a round of the Epynt Motor Club Ltd. Auto-Test Championship.
29. A competitor's best five scores will count for the championship.
- a. If six rounds are not run then the championship will be decided on by the total number of rounds, minus their worst score.
30. Overall championship awards will be presented at the Epynt Motor Club Annual Dinner and Awards Presentation.
- a. Points will be presented as follows:-
 - b. 1st in Class (10 Championship Points)
 - c. 2nd in Class (9 Championship Points)
 - d. 10th in Class (1 Championship Points)
 - e. All entrants will be automatically awarded 1 championship if not placed in the top 10.

Safety

31. Any drivers who drive in a dangerous manner outside of the tests will be excluded from the event.
32. All competitors must wear a helmet and seat belt whilst competing.
- a. The sharing of helmets is not permitted, unless from within the same physical household.



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Coronavirus Specific Regulations.

1. The event has been risk assessed, and will work inline to that risk assessment, which is available upon request. The relevant information will be shared in the joining instructions.
2. The following Supplementary Regulations have been altered due to COVID19. This and those below may change between tests. Please ensure you read this document fully to understand the changes need to run a safe, enjoyable event inline with COVID19 regulations.
 - A) 5 (*Licenses & Membership Applications must be made in advance*)
 - B) 7 (*reduction of maximum participants*)
 - C) 20 (*entries cannot be made on the day of the event*)
 - D) 21 (*Payment must be made in advance of the event*)
 - E) 24 (*No sharing of cars.*)
 - F) 16 (*Route Information will be supplied in advance of the event*)
 - G) 17 (*How the tests will be timed and starting procedure*)
 - H) 22 (*acknowledgment and acceptance of entries*)
 - I) 32 (*No sharing of helmets*)
3. Should there be a change in Welsh Government COVID19 Regulations or Motorsport UK Guidelines which makes the event unviable or unlawful to run a full refund will be made.
 - A) If you develop symptoms prior to the event, then a full refund will be made, providing you make the organisers aware as soon as possible.
4. PPE will not be supplied to competitors; we strongly recommend they bring hand sanitiser. Gloves and Face Masks / Shields are recommended. Marshals will be supplied with Gloves, Masks and Hand Sanitiser. Marshals will also be supplied with a handheld radio and route diagrams. These will be packaged together at least 3 days before the event. Social Distancing will be strictly enforced and must be adhered to by all in attendance.

6. Your contact details will held and should someone in attendance test positive these will be passed to the NHS Track and Trace team who will make contact with you. 7. If following the event you find out you have been exposed to COVID19 in the 14 days before the event or develop symptoms, you must inform the event as soon as possible, please contact the COVID19 Officer Emma Lewis; 07939 226 442.
8. You must not attend the event if you have any symptoms of COVID19 on the day or in the 14 days before the event. The official symptoms are: high temperature, new continuous cough, and loss of taste or smell.
9. Results will also be displayed on a whiteboard on the day, please ensure social distancing is adhered to when looking.



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10. Signing on will be completed virtually, once an entry form has been submitted and accepted by the organisers, competitors will be asked to 'sign-on' to the event via another form, usually done at the event. Competitors will not be permitted to start without both forms being completed and payment received.
11. Competitors must not bring anyone else to the event with them (unless they are from the same household / bubble and are a registered marshal or contender). Anyone not adhering to this rule will be turned away from the event.
12. Should your vehicle leave the route you must acknowledge the marshal with a thumb up gesture to confirm you are okay. If you need medical assistance use the thumb down gesture. If you are stuck and need assistance, marshals will need to don PPE before rendering assistance.
13. There will be a designated first aider on the event, should you need first aid assistance, maintain social distancing until they have donned the correct PPE and ask you to come closer.
14. There will be no food or toilet facilities during the event, competitors must bring their own food and refreshments.
